Hey Members!

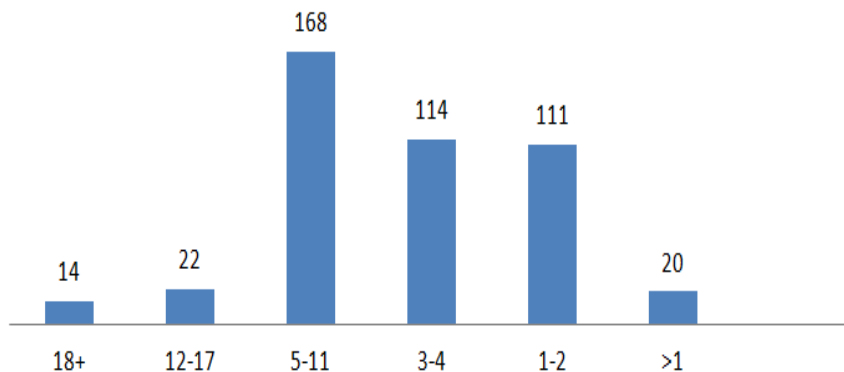
